Figure 1 – ECLP priority countries

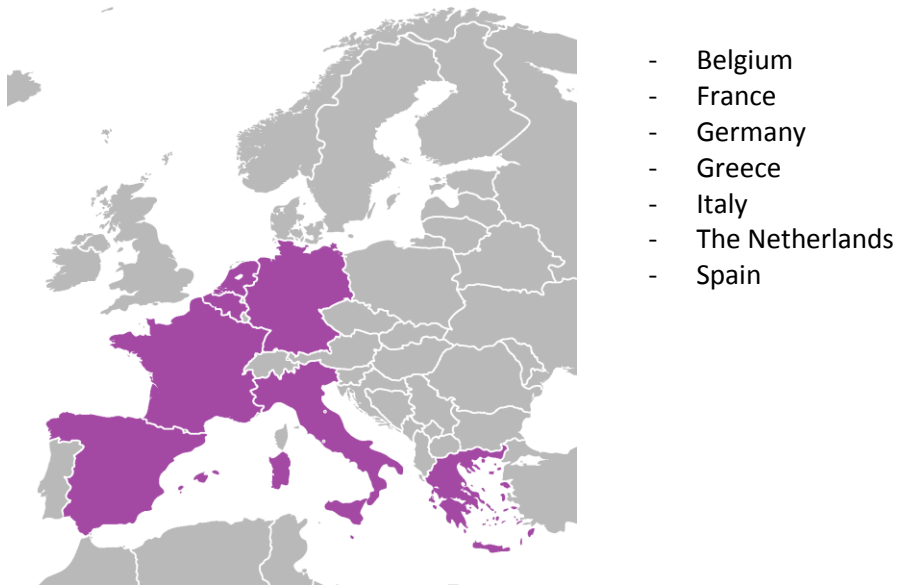


Figure 2 – ECLP Expense Distribution by Areas of Work between January 2013 - June 2014

- Capacity Building on Video and Social Network Usage - 11%

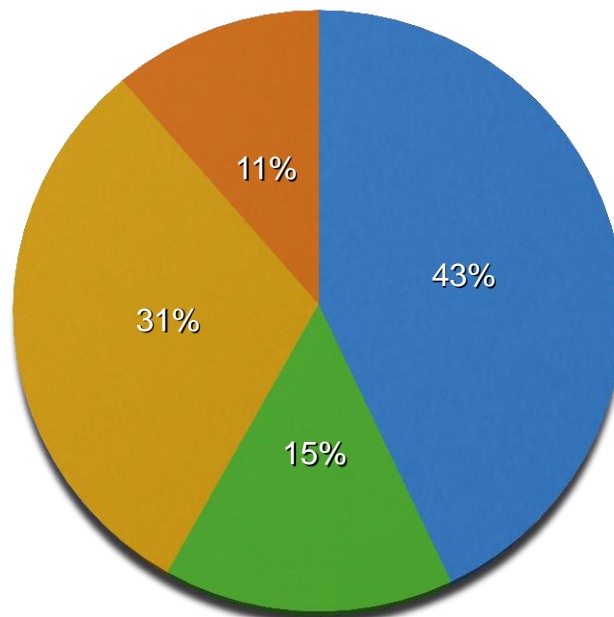


Figure 3 – ECLP Expense Distribution by Tools between January 2013 – June 2014

- Grants - 59%

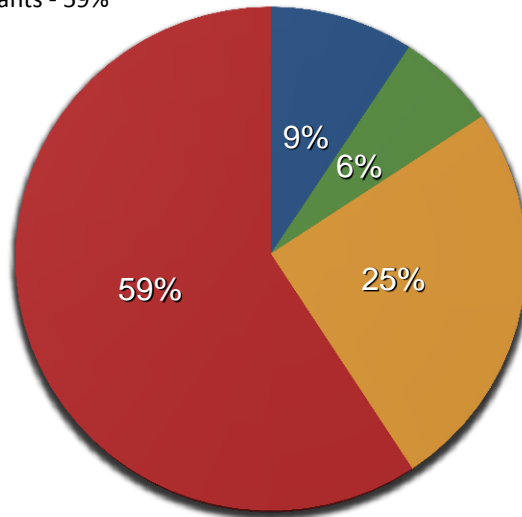


Figure 4 – ECLP Grant Distribution by European Region

- South-East Europe

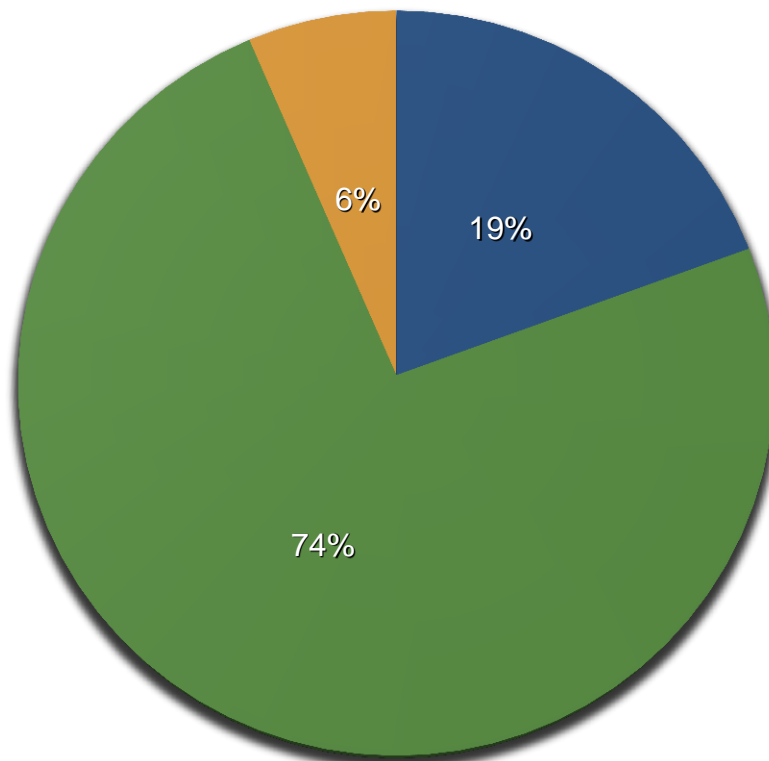

The project aimed to address important human rights and civil liberties issues with starting impact litigation in the Netherlands, offering its services to different human rights groups, and also to look proactively for possible cases, and to embed litigation into its broader human rights advocacy agenda. This is a 2 year long pilot project; after two years, the NJCM will decide whether it wants to continue with the project or if it will start a spin off and to run the project by a separate organization.
